## 2016 School Fees

### **New Students -**

Enrolment Fee: \$50

Acceptance Fee: \$100

Family Bond: \$1,000 (Fully refundable, upon application, with one term's notice of withdrawal of student)

### **All Students – Levy Payments required by Week 1, 2016**

Family Building (Capital) Levy: \$200 (Annual) – Compulsory per family

Stationery Levy: \$200 (Annual) – Compulsory per student

Excursions, Incursions, Swimming and Extra Curricular Activity Fee: \$300 (Annual) – Compulsory per student

Arts Levy: \$100 (Annual) – Compulsory per student

### **Student 1 – Full Fee (tuition fees)**

Yearly Tuition Fee: \$4,000

*\*Applying \$300 discount for upfront payment (\$300): \$3,700*

Paid by Term: \$1000

Paid by Month, Feb-Nov: \$400 over ten months (late fee of 20% applies if payment not received by the 8th of each month)

### **Student 2 - 10% deduction (tuition fees)**

Yearly Fee: \$3,600

*\*Applying \$200 discount for Upfront payment (\$200): \$3,400*

Paid by Term: \$900

Paid by Month, Feb-Nov: \$360 (Late fee of 20% applies if payment not received by the 8th of each month)

### **Third Child and Subsequent Children - 15% discount (tuition fees)**

Yearly Fee: \$3,400

*\*Applying \$200 discount for upfront payment (\$200.00): \$3,200*

Paid by Term: \$850

Paid by Month, Feb-Nov: \$340 (Late fee of 20% applies if payment not received by the 8th of each month)



### Tuition Fees – Family Concessions

Tuition fee concessions are offered to families with more than one child. The eldest child in the family, enrolled at the college, is considered the first child in every case. Second child receives a 10% deduction on school fees and the third and subsequent child in each family, receives a 15% deduction on tuition fees.

**NB:** Levies cannot be included in extended payment options, available for the payment of tuition fees. All levies must be paid, in full, by January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2016.

### Payment Options

#### Option 1 – Upfront Payment

Payment of the total amount owing for tuition fees and levies within one week of the start of the school year - by January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2016 - will receive a \$300 discount for the first child and \$200 discount off the tuition fee deducted from the fee of the second and subsequent students of the same family. Payment options are Internet Transfer, Cheque or cash. Upfront payments can be emailed or phoned through to the office.

#### Option 2 – School Plan

*School Plan* is an annual school fee payment service that spreads your child's fees into manageable monthly payments. *School Plan* pays the yearly fees directly to Queensland Independent College by the due date, availing of the early payment concession offer. #### Option 3 – Direct Debit

The Direct Debit payment solution can be tailored to a suitable frequency (eg. weekly, fortnightly or monthly) through our Ezidebit payment management system. Please note families availing of this option will not be entitled to the early payment concession and transactional fees will apply.

All accounts must be completed and paid, in full, by the close of business on the last day of Term 4, 2016. Outstanding account balances held after this date are not guaranteed placement in 2017.

### Terms of Payment

- All fees are due and payable within the first week of Term 1, of the school year.
- Fees outstanding after the due date, without an approved School Plan or Ezidebit plan, will automatically incur a \$50 late fee.
- Enrolments may be cancelled for any unapproved outstanding fees at the end of every term.
- A full term's notice, in writing, is required for withdrawal of your child/children from Queensland Independent College. Failure to do so will result in the forfeit of your Family Bond, in lieu of payment. There are no exceptions to this term of payment.
- Should a child be suspended or expelled from the college, the current term's fees remain payable.
